PBL 101 WORKSHOP - (Sessions Offered: Elementary K-5 and Secondary 6-12)

Based on the Gold Standard PBL model, this three-day PBL 101 Workshop engages participants in learning how to design, assess, and manage a rigorous, relevant, standards-based project. The workshop models the project process. Participants are actively engaged in project design, with the expectation that every teacher or teaching team will generate a project plan that receives formative feedback from the facilitator and participants.

PBL 201 WORKSHOP - Improving the Quality of Student Work: (Prerequisite: PBL 101 Workshop)

UPDATED content for 2020!! In this engaging and interactive workshop, participants will investigate and apply teaching practices and strategies that can help to strengthen the quality of student work in a PBL classroom. They will develop and reflect on a high-quality project, and will plan for project implementation in order to improve student products and enhance learning.

PBL COACHING WORKSHOP - (Prerequisite PBL 101 Workshop)

The PBL Coaching Workshop provides instructional coaches and leaders with the knowledge and skills to support teachers in project implementation. The workshop focuses on strategies coaches can use to support and enable high quality PBL implementation. Participants will review the PBL Teaching Practices through a coaching lens, explore resources and protocols, learn to use a PBL Coaching Cycle, and develop a PBL Coaching Toolkit to use at their school sites.

PBL LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP - (For School and District Leadership Teams of at least 3 if possible)

The PBL Leadership Team Workshop is a three-day intensive dive into how school and district leaders support the conditions for Project Based Learning to thrive in their systems. Reflecting on their current reality, participants will design their strategy to implement PBL and foster a project based mindset for teaching, learning and leading that moves them forward along the PBL Leadership Progression of Practice.
