Concurrent Enrollment at Cherokee Trail

Follow these steps to help you complete your application to start the qualification process for CE College Credit.



Go to ccaurora.edu/apply

Once on the site, you will need to click on "New" to begin an application (only complete if you have not previously enrolled in CCA)



Create Your CCA Account

This will include info like your name, birthdate, and contact info. Make sure you select that you will be starting classes in Fall 2023.



Start Your Application

Click "Create a New Application" and then "Start a new Undergraduate Application." From here, select "Fall 2023" and then "Complete Selected Application."



Check Your Personal Information

Make sure this section has been completed accurately and that autofill didn't change anything.



Academic Information

Student Type: "No" for "Are you a student at another college, THEN "No, I am a current high school student who will not graduate prior to " Academic Plans:

Select Fall 2023 and then "Take college courses while I am still in high school" Academic Area can be an area you are interested in pursuing or the course you are taking this year.

High School--enter Cherokee Trail and click on it when it pops up.

Say "Yes" to the question Have you or will you earn a high school diploma? Month you earned or anticipate earning: MAY

Year--the year you will graduate from Cherokee Trail

Residency Information

Some of this information is required and some is optional. Input what you know.

Demographic Information

You will need to address military status (of your family) and answer selective service based on birth gender.



College Opportunity Fund (COF)

Select "Yes, Apply on my behalf" (this is what makes the college CE credit free) THEN complete the final steps of the application and submit!
