Scholastic Art & Writing Awards are the nation's longest-running and most prestigious recognition program for creative teens in grades 7–12, ages 13+ and had been a program in Colorado since 1947.

It is the equivalent to state qualifiers in a sport, or honor band selections in our performing arts. Out of the thousands of submissions, awards are given to the top ten percent, with Silver Keys accounting for the top six percent, and gold keys representing the top three percent of all submissions.

All award winners will have their work on display in a professional gallery during the month of February; these locations include the Chancery Building in Denver, 40 West Gallery in Lakewood, and the Denver Art Museum. Any student who received a Gold Key will have their pieces considered in the national competition.

Boys Basketball (Head Coach Ryan Turk, rturk@cherrycreekschools.org) The Wolves are currently 8-8 and striving to get into the CHSAA post season. Grandview will wrap up the regular season with Arapahoe, Overland, Smoky Hill, Cherry Creek, and then the Centennial League Basketball Tournament.

Wrestling (Head Coach Ryan Budd, rbudd@cherrycreekschools.org) The Wolves Wrestling Team had a great month of January competing in CA at the prestigious Doc Buchanan Invitational as well as Top of the Rockies and Arvada West, two of the toughest local tournaments in Colorado. Grandview won the Arvada West tournament for the first time in school history beating CO #1 ranked Pomona. The Wolves followed that up by taking 2nd at Top of the Rockies competing against some of the toughest teams in the state, all classifications combined. Last weekend, the Wolves wrestlers dominated the Centennial League Tournament taking the #1 team spot by over 50 points, 8 out of 14 wrestlers earning 1st team All-League accolades. The Wolves will head into regionals next week at Broomfield ranked 3rd in the state narrowly behind the top 2 teams.

Girls Swim & Dive (Head Coach James Boone, jboone@cherrycreekschools.org) The Girls Swim & Dive team is building momentum heading into championship season. It will be a close battle for 2nd between the Wolves, Arapahoe and CT. So far this season Addison Campbell is undefeated in Diving and looking to continue that through A Leagues and State! Addi has also broken the team record in 6 dives. On the swimming side, the team has multiple swims among the top times in the state. Makenna Dyk is currently 6th in the 50 Free and 100 Free and is also top seed in the 50 Free at the A League meet. The team's top event is 200 Free Relay ranking 5th in the state, with an all-underclassmen team of Makenna Dyk, Jasia Barnes, Paige Gust and Delaina Burgeson. In the 200 Medley Relay and 400 Free Relay, Grandview ranks 11th. The team will be taking 23 swimmers and 5 divers to A Leagues and so far, has qualified 8 swimmers and 1 diver for State. We look forward to competing as hard as we can to finish the season.

Ice Hockey (Head Coach Josh Schaffer, jschaffer3@cherrycreekschools.org) Grandview Ice Hockey regular season is around the corner. As the Wolves continue to get better, they look to go on a run at the end of the season to make a post season push in its inaugural season. Grandview will finish the season with games against Lewis Palmer, Dakota Ridge, Chaparral, Colorado Academy, and Heritage.

Athletic Registration is currently open for all Spring sports.

All athletes must complete the athletic registration process and be cleared through the Athletic Department before participating in the CHSAA season. Athletic registration is open for all seasons.

Spring athletic registration is currently open. The deadline to ensure participation on the first day is February 10 for Boys' Volleyball and Boys' Swim & Dive, February 17 for all other sports. All Winter participants must be cleared through the Athletics Office before they can participate.

Click on the Wolf Head.

Scroll down to Create Family Account.

It will ask you for your student's Last Name exactly how it is in Powerschool (if your student is a Jr or the III this will need to be added or the system will not accept the last name) and Student ID.

Next, will ask for an email and password. The system will send an email notification to activate your account. Once activated you will then go back and log in with your credentials.

The registration will take about 10 minutes.

If you have a physical for your child, please upload this in the proper section. **PHYSICALS MUST BE TURNED IN OR UPLOADED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING.**

The last step is to pay \$90, you may choose to Pay Later.

Click Submit and this will link your student to your family account.

If returning from last year or participated in any previous sport this year, you will still need to re-register your student for 2024-2025 school year.

GRANDVIEW GIRLS' SOCCER – Spring 2025

Our 2025 season begins on February 24th. Girls that would like to play soccer this spring should refer to the information below.

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION IS OPENS LATER THIS SEMESTER!

Athletes that wish to play soccer in the spring must complete the online registration that is on the Grandview website: <https://grandviewhs-ar.schooltoday.com/node/26>

The forms include in the athletics registration link on the school website (Athletics section), as well as a physical completed by a medical professional, MUST be completed no later than February 10th, 2025 so that girls will be eligible to participate in practices beginning on February 24th (our first official day). Please complete these forms ASAP after the link becomes active (December/January).

FIRST OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAY

~~Our first official practice date is~~ Monday, February 24th, 2025. We will begin our tryout process on that date. Practice will be held outside on the grass fields at Grandview from 3:45 – 5:45 each day that week unless the fields are covered with snow. If fields are not playable then we will modify the schedule to utilize indoor spaces at Grandview. Players should be prepared to be outside on that date as well as have gear for indoor training if necessary.

PRESEASON CAMP

We will have a preseason camp for girls wishing to participate in our spring season starting on Thursday, January 16th. This camp is optional for players but highly recommended so that players are ready for the season. Here is information for this camp:

Description:

This conditioning and skills camp will prepare players for the upcoming spring soccer season. The camp will focus on strength, injury prevention, conditioning, and technical work with a ball. Sessions will be held in the hallway or on the turf field when field and weather conditions permit. Athletes should wear running shoes and bring soccer cleats, shin guards, and a water bottle. Athletes should be prepared for both indoor and outdoor sessions.



EVACUATION/FIRE DRILL

The school is evacuated due to a safety concern inside of the building.

SECURE PERIMETER

All exterior doors are locked in response to a concern of a threat outside of the building. Business is conducted as usual inside of the building.

LOCKDOWN

Students and staff take immediate shelter in response to a concern of a threat inside of the building.

SHELTER-IN-PLACE (SEVERE WEATHER)

Students and staff move to "tornado safe" areas on campus, which typically means on the first floor away from windows and doors.

Grandview High School is committed to providing a learning environment where students, staff and community members feel safe. This includes attention to both physical and psychological school safety. Each year, we revise our Readiness and Emergency Management for Schools (REMS) Template, which outlines important safety procedures we follow. This includes items such as our drill schedules and plans for preparation and response to potential school emergencies. On a regular basis we conduct Fire, Secure Perimeter, and Lockdown drills, and we continuously revisit and revise all safety procedures. All of our procedures are designed in accordance with recommendations of best practice made from both external agencies and the Cherry Creek School District. By establishing such proactive measure, and continually reflecting upon and adjusting our plans as needed, Grandview High School strives to promote and maintain a safe learning environment. 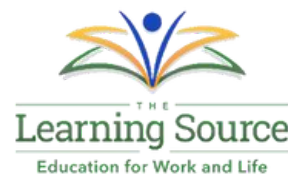

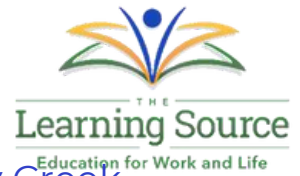
