

Any student who received a Gold Key will have their pieces considered in the national competition.

Wrestling (Head Coach Ryan Budd, rbudd@cherrycreekschools.org) The Wolves Wrestling Team had a great month of January competing in CA at the prestigious Doc Buchanan Invitational as well as Top of the Rockies and Arvada West, two of the toughest local tournaments in Colorado. Grandview won the Arvada West tournament for the first time in school history beating CO #1 ranked Pomona. The Wolves followed that up by taking 2nd at Top of the Rockies competing against some of the toughest teams in the state, all classifications combined. Last weekend, the Wolves wrestlers dominated the Centennial League Tournament taking the #1 team spot by over 50 points, 8 out of 14 wrestlers earning 1st team All-League accolades. The Wolves will head into regionals next week at Broomfield ranked 3rd in the state narrowly behind the top 2 teams.

Girls Swim & Dive (Head Coach James Boone, jboone@cherrycreekschools.org) The Girls Swim & Dive team is building momentum heading into championship season. It will be a close battle for 2nd between the Wolves, Arapahoe and CT. So far this season Addison Campbell is undefeated in Diving and looking to continue that through A Leagues and State! Addi has also broken the team record in 6 dives. On the swimming side, the team has multiple swims among the top times in the state. Makenna Dyk is currently 6th in the 50 Free and 100 Free and is also top seed in the 50 Free at the A League meet. The team's top event is 200 Free Relay ranking 5th in the state, with an all-underclassmen team of Makenna Dyk, Jasia Barnes, Paige Gust and Delaina Burgeson. In the 200 Medley Relay and 400 Free Relay, Grandview ranks 11th. The team will be taking 23 swimmers and 5 divers to A Leagues and so far, has qualified 8 swimmers and 1 diver for State. We look forward to competing as hard as we can to finish the season.

As the Wolves continue to get better, they look to go on a run at the end of the season to make a post season push in its inaugural season. It will ask you for your student's Last Name exactly how it is in Powerschool (if your student is a Jr or the III this will need to be added or the system will not accept the last name) and Student ID.

Next, will ask for an email and password. The system will send an email notification to activate your account. Once activated you will then go back and log in with your credentials.

The registration will take about 10 minutes.

If you have a physical for your child, please upload this in the proper section. **PHYSICALS MUST BE TURNED IN OR UPLOADED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING.**

The last step is to pay \$90, you may choose to Pay Later.

Click Submit and this will link your student to your family account.

If returning from last year or participated in any previous sport this year, you will still need to reregister your student for 2024-2025 school year.

GRANDVIEW GIRLS' SOCCER – Spring 2025



Our 2025 season begins on February 24th. Girls that would like to play soccer this spring should refer to the information below.

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION IS OPENS LATER THIS SEMESTER!

Athletes that wish to play soccer in the spring must complete the online registration that is on the Grandview website: https://grandviewhs-ar.rschooltoday.com/node/26

The forms include in the athletics registration link on the school website (Athletics section), as well as a physical completed by a medical professional, MUST be completed no later than February 10th, 2025 so that girls will be eligible to participate in practices beginning on February 24th (our first official day). Please complete these forms ASAP after the link becomes active (December/January).

FIRST OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAY

Our first official practice date is Monday, February 24th, 2025. We will begin our tryout process on that date. Practice will be held outside on the grass fields at Grandview from 3:45 – 5:45 each day that week unless the fields are covered with snow. If fields are not playable then we will modify the schedule to utilize indoor spaces at Grandview. Players should be prepared to be outside on that date as well as have gear for indoor training if necessary.

PRESEASON CAMP

We will have a preseason camp for girls wishing to participate in our spring season starting on Thursday, January 16th. This camp is optional for players but highly recommended so that players are ready for the season. Here is information for this camp:

Description:

This conditioning and skills camp will prepare players for the upcoming spring soccer season. The camp will focus on strength, injury prevention, conditioning, and technical work with a ball. Sessions will be held in the hallway or on the turf field when field and weather conditions permit. Athletes should wear running shoes and bring soccer cleats, shin guards, and a water bottle. Athletes should be prepared for both indoor and outdoor sessions.

Grandview High School is a closed campus during the school day for all 9th graders, meaning 9th graders are not permitted to leave campus at any time. It is strongly encouraged (but not required) 10th graders remain on campus during regular school hours, including during lunch. To enhance the learning environment, no food will be allowed in the academic hallways. Additional students will not be permitted in the academic hallways during lunch hours without a pass from their teacher.

SCHOOL SAFETY

Grandview High School is committed to providing a learning environment where students, staff and community members feel safe. This includes attention to both physical and psychological school safety. Each year, we revise our Readiness and Emergency Management for Schools (REMS) Template, which outlines important safety procedures we follow. This includes items such as our drill schedules and plans for preparation and response to potential school emergencies. On a regular basis we conduct Fire, Secure Perimeter, and Lockdown drills, and we continuously revisit and revise all safety procedures.
