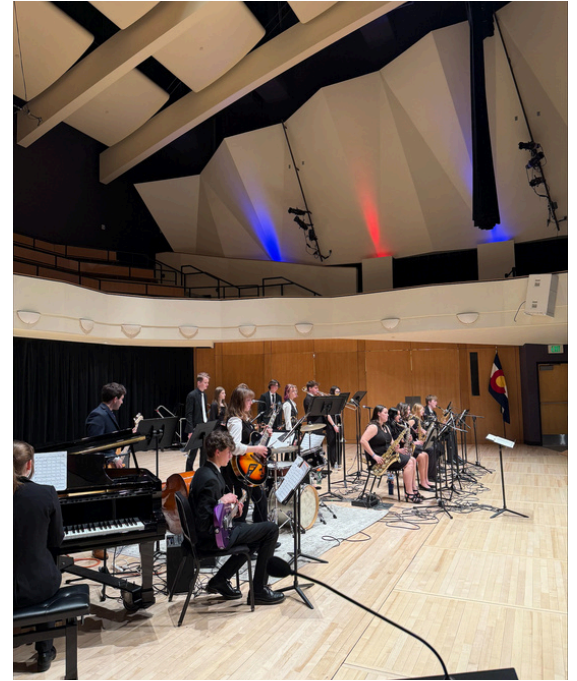

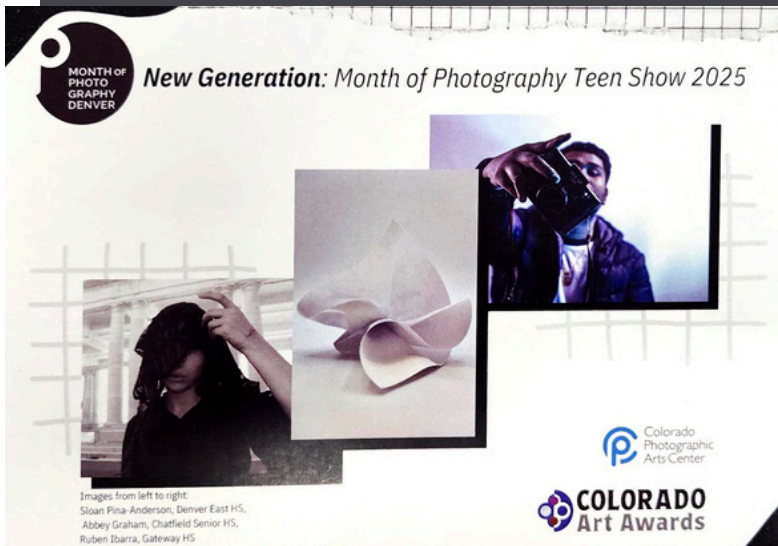

Grandview was also undefeated in dual meets this season going 13-0 and captured the Centennial League Championship. Senior Charlie Herting finished his career with 136 pins and 163 wins to secure the number one spot in school history for pins and wins.

Makenna & Paige teamed up with Junior Emma Busta and Sophomore Jasia Barnes to win the B final in the 400 Free relay and place 6th in the 200 Free Relay with an All-American Consideration time of 1:36.53. The 200 Medley Relay team of Teagen Boskovich (So.), Ella Kozlowski (So.), Baylie Renner (Sr.) and Delaina Burgeson (Fr.) also scored at state, with a 13th place finish. We thank our senior class for an outstanding season and look forward to this young team continuing to grow and improve!



Grandview High School is a closed campus during the school day for all 9th graders, meaning 9th graders are not permitted to leave campus at any time. It is strongly encouraged (but not required) 10th graders remain on campus during regular school hours, including during lunch. To enhance the learning environment, no food will be allowed in the academic hallways. EVACUATION/FIRE DRILL

SECURE PERIMETER

All exterior doors are locked in response to a concern of a threat outside of the building. Business is conducted as usual inside of the building.

LOCKDOWN

Students and staff take immediate shelter in response to a concern of a threat inside of the building.

SHELTER-IN-PLACE (SEVERE WEATHER)

Students and staff move to "tornado safe" areas on campus, which typically means on the first floor away from windows and doors.

Grandview High School is committed to providing a learning environment where students, staff and community members feel safe. This includes attention to both physical and psychological school safety. Each year, we revise our Readiness and Emergency Management for Schools (REMS) Template, which outlines important safety procedures we follow. This includes items such as our drill schedules and plans for preparation and response to potential school emergencies. On a regular basis we conduct Fire, Secure Perimeter, and Lockdown drills, and we continuously revisit and revise all safety procedures. All of our procedures are designed in accordance with recommendations of best practice made from both external agencies and the Cherry Creek School District. By establishing such proactive measure, and continually reflecting upon and adjusting our plans as needed, Grandview High School strives to promote and maintain a safe learning environment. - A student **MAY NOT** be excused by a parent or guardian from classes while the student is on campus, including to make-up work or to take a test for another class.

- Medical Notes

If your child is absent for a doctor's appointment, dentist appointment or with any medical professional and a signed doctor's note is provided, the absence will be marked excused medical (M) and will not count towards the student's total number of absences.

Colorado State - Compulsory School Attendance Law

According to the [Colorado Compulsory School Attendance Law](#) (C.R.S. 22-33-101 et seq.), it is the obligation of every parent/guardian to ensure that their child attends school for at least 1,056 hours in high school during each school year.

Cherry Creek School District Board Policy JH - Acceptable Excused Absences

[Per Cherry Creek School Board Policy](#) The following shall be considered excused absences:

1. A student who is temporarily ill or injured, or whose absence is approved by the administrator of the school of attendance on a pre-arranged basis. Pre-arranged absences shall be approved for appointments or circumstances of a serious nature only which cannot be taken care of outside of school hours.
2. A student who is absent for an extended period due to physical, mental or emotional disability.
3. A student who is pursuing a work-study program under the supervision of the school.
4. A student who is attending any school-sponsored activity or activities of an educational nature with advance approval by the administration.
5. A student who is absent in observance of an established religious holiday.
6. A student whose absence is approved by the building principal at the request of the parent or guardian.
7. A student who is suspended or expelled.

The District may require suitable proof regarding the above exceptions, including written statements from medical sources.

If a student in an out-of-home placement (as that term is defined by C.R.S. § 22-32-138(1)(e), is absent due to court appearances and participation in court-ordered activities, such absences shall be excused. The student's assigned social worker shall verify the student's absence was for a court appearance or court-ordered activity.

Cherry Creek School District Board Policy - Unexcused Absences

[Per Cherry Creek School Board Policy](#), an unexcused absence is defined as an absence that is not covered by one of the foregoing exceptions.

Continued unexcused absences and/or repeated tardiness may be considered cause for disciplinary action. In accordance with law, the District may impose appropriate penalties that relate directly to classes missed while unexcused. Penalties may include a warning, school detention or in-school suspension.

Cherry Creek School District - Chronic Absenteeism

Chronic absenteeism is defined by the state as missing more than 10 days in the school year. If your child is chronically absent, or misses more than 10 days of school, parents or guardians will receive a letter from the district on behalf of our school notifying them of the issue. You will receive a second letter if your child misses more than 15 days of school.

Our hope in automating this notification process at the district level is to provide our school staff with more time to meet with caregivers and problem-solve if your child or family needs extra support to attend school every day.

- **10 Days (40 class periods) Absent Letter**
 - ☐ This letter will be automatically sent when a student misses 10 school days (excused or unexcused).
- **15 Days (60 class periods) Absent Letter**
 - ☐ This letter will be automatically sent when a student has missed 15 school days (excused or unexcused). This letter also contains language around a "doctor's note" being needed to excuse further absences.
- **Sanction Letter**
 - ☐ If the student has an equivalent of 25 missed school days, a sanction letter can be requested.
- **Student Attendance Review Board (SARB)**
 - ☐ When the student has an equivalent to 30 missed school days, the school will send a Student Attendance Review Board (SARB) Meeting request to the truancy department.
 - ☐ A meeting will be scheduled by the Legal Office with the Dean, CCSD Truancy, Juvenile Assessment Center (JAC), DHS, and other outside agencies.

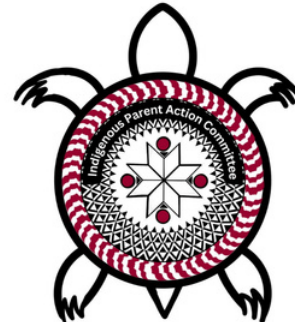
