We will also have many of our families hosting their own tables with activities, food, and displays. If you are interested in participating, please fill out the participation form in this newsletter.



About the Program

Summer EBT helps families buy food during the summer months. If you qualify, you will get \$40 per child for each month when school is not in session. This amounts to up to \$120 per child. You'll receive a card pre-loaded with money in the mail.

You Are Eligible If...

- You already participate in SNAP, TANF or Medicaid
- Your child attends a school that offers the National School Lunch or School Breakfast program and you qualify based on income

How Can You Receive Benefits?

- 1. Make sure your school has a benefits form or household income application on file
 - For the Cherry Creek School District you may apply at www.myschoolapps.com
- 2. Make sure your school has your current address and parent/guardian information
- 3. Your family will automatically qualify if you participate in SNAP, TANF or Medicaid
