Covid Reporting:

The uncertainty of Covid 19 continues to present challenges in our lives. We have had a handful of Covid positive cases confirmed and I would like to take this opportunity to explain the reporting process that is in place across the district:

- 1. As positive cases are reported to us, we communicate, through a ConnectEd email, to the grade level families affected.

 Names of individuals reported as positive are **not** disclosed as this information is confidential and protected by law.
- Contact tracing and guidance for quarantines are conducted by Tri-County Health. If a quarantine is required for any individual, or group of students, it will be communicated to us through Tri-County. We, in turn, will contact individuals or groups of the need to quarantine based on Tri-County's guidance.
- 3. Our school nurse works with families to report Covid positive cases within our community. She no longer contact traces with the principal as this role has been replaced by Tri-County health. Please **DO** call the school with questions or concerns about your child's health.
- 4. If your child(ren) exhibit any of the following symptoms, please keep them at home and contact the school:

a) sore throat

f.) muscle/body aches

b) cough

g.) fatigue

c)fever

h.) nausea/vomiting

d)head-ache

i.) loss of taste/smell

e)Runny nose/congestion

BUS PARKING








Yes, meals are free this school year, but did you know that approved meal applications have benefits that go beyond meals?

Students with approved applications on file can access a wide range of non-meal benefits such as discounts on fees for sports, testing and Before and After Care services.






