<u>Our Mission:</u> At Mountain Vista we work together to ensure academic and social emotional growth for every student, every day.

<u>Our Vision:</u> Mountain Vista students will be equipped with the knowledge, skills, and character to succeed in a world that is yet to be created.

Important Information specific to Mountain Vista Elementary:

#### Arrival time/Dismissal:

- Students may arrive at 7:45 a.m., tardy bell rings at 8:00 a.m. (no supervision is provided prior to 7:45 a.m. except for students eating breakfast)
- Dismissal is 2:45 p.m. (1:45 p.m. on Wednesdays)
- All students should leave campus at dismissal. Students may not stay to play on the playground unless supervised by a parent/guardian.
- Students may arrive for breakfast at 7:30 a.m. They will eat in the cafeteria until 7:50 a.m. and then be dismissed. Pre-K parents need to stay with their children if they are eating breakfast.
- If your student needs to leave early, keep in mind:
  - Children will not be called to the office until a parent arrives.
  - We do not allow children to be signed out of school after 2:25 p.m. (1:25 p.m. on Wednesdays).
    Please wait until dismissal or arrive earlier.
- There is no school for Pre-K children on Fridays.
- Extended childcare is provided for students ages 5-12 from 6:30 am to 6 p.m. Please contact Kristy Petrocco, <u>kdwyer-petrocco@cherrycreekschools.org</u> or 720-886-2715 for information.

#### Drop off/Pick up:

- Please drive carefully and watch for people/students walking in the parking lot.
- If you'd like to walk your student to their entrance door, please park in the parking lot and use the crosswalks with crossing guards (the NW crosswalk is closed).
- Students should enter the west doors (at the far end of the building off Radcliff).
- Parents may walk students to the entry but are asked not to enter the building.
- Do not drop off in the bus loop, the lower parking lot, near the dumpsters, or by the delivery dock.
- The front of the building is a hug and go zone. Students will exit their car with staff assistance in the drop off zone.
- We ask that family pets stay at home. Please do not bring them onto campus.



### Breakfast/Lunch

- Free breakfast and lunch is served every day. Breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m.
- Students can purchase a' la carte items from the cafeteria.

#### Weather:

- Delayed/No School will be announced on local news stations and will be announced through district communication.
- If a delayed start is called, doors will open at 8:45 a.m. with breakfast at 8:30 a.m.
- We go out for recess if the "feels like" temperature is at or above 20 degrees, and the playground is safe to play on.

#### Attendance:

- As stated in board policy JH, student's success in school is directly related to regular and punctual attendance. Students need to be at school, on time, every day.
- Attendance is mandatory per policy JEA. If student absences (excused or unexcused) extend beyond 10 days, you may receive reminders from the school and/or district reminding you of policy.
- In case of sickness or absence, please call the 24 hour attendance line at 720-886-2795.
- If a student is not called in absent by 8:15, we are required to call you to confirm your child is unaccounted for at school and is safe.
- Board policy JH states students may request make up work upon returning from an absence.
- If you plan to take an extended (10+ days) vacation, you will be required to unenroll your student and re-enroll them upon your return. We cannot guarantee the same classroom placement upon return.

#### Toys, Trinkets, Items from Home, etc:

- Students are discouraged from bringing cell phones, smart watches and other technology (unless arranged with the classroom teacher).
- The school is not responsible for lost personal items.
- Bringing personal items such as toys, trading cards, figurines, sports equipment, etc. is prohibited.

#### Wheels on Campus:

- We welcome bikes, scooters, and skateboards, please remember to walk them on campus.
- There is a bike rack out back to store bicycles, we recommend locking your bike.
- No motorized wheels.
- Helmets are recommended.
- We do not allow "heely's" (wheeled tennis shoes).

#### **Communication:**

- On the last Friday of every month families will receive an electronic school newsletter, *Mammoth Tracks*
- Teachers will regularly share feedback via email or a weekly folder.
- Parent/Teacher conferences are held twice a year, once in the fall and once in the spring.

#### Behavior:

- We follow district behavior expectations and incorporate S.T.O.M.P. into Mountain Vista expectations (Safety, Trustworthiness, Ownership, Motivation, Positivity).
- We focus on positive reinforcement and work to allow students to utilize restorative justice practices to resolve conflicts.
- The teacher or principal will notify parents of persistent behaviors or more significant behaviors in order to partner together to support the child in making positive choices at school.

#### School Celebrations:

- There will be 3 classroom parties throughout the year Winter, Valentines and End-of-Year.
- If you'd like to recognize your child's birthday, you may send in a small store purchased treat or small non-edible item that can be handed out to the class during a convenient time for the teacher. No balloons or flowers.
- Children may not distribute invitations at school for personal parties.

#### Volunteers:

- We have active PTO and PASS committees. We welcome you to attend and/or volunteer.

#### Questions/Concerns/Comments:

- The district follows the Standard Response Protocol from the I Love You Guys Foundation.
- We practice monthly fire drills.
- We practice 2 lockdown drills a year which will be announced to students and families prior to practicing.
