CONCURRENT/DUAL ENROLLMENT 2024-2025

Concurrent Enrollment: Earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. Courses offered through local community colleges and taught at CCSD high schools by accredited, post-secondary teachers. Courses are free if the student completes the required paperwork including Colorado Opportunity Fund (COF).

Dual Enrollment: Similar to Concurrent Enrollment. Families incur a small tuition cost to enroll. Courses offered through Metropolitan State University of Denver and taught at CCSD high schools.

For the course to be tuition free, the student must apply for COF (College Opportunity Fund) during the college application process.
