

## GRANDVIEW HIGH SCHOOL CONCURRENT/DUAL ENROLLMENT 2024-2025

**Concurrent Enrollment:** Earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. Courses offered through local community colleges and taught at CCSD high schools by accredited, post-secondary teachers. Courses are free if the student completes the required paperwork including Colorado Opportunity Fund (COF) and meets the prerequisites. Courses offered through Community College of Aurora and Arapahoe Community College and taught at CCSD high schools.

**Dual Enrollment:** Similar to Concurrent Enrollment. Families incur a small tuition cost to enroll. Courses offered through Metro State and University of Colorado Denver and taught at CCSD high schools.
