

How to apply for Internships and Apprenticeships

Work-Based Learning Job Board

- Opportunities are for summer, fall, and spring of the upcoming academic year.
- Internships and apprenticeships are generally for rising juniors and seniors
- Internships are short-term and usually unpaid
- Apprenticeships are long-term and always paid
- Earn school credit towards graduation
- If hired, your schedule is crafted around coursework and apprenticeship/internship requirements

Key points:

- Students will only see opportunities that they are eligible for based on age and/or CTE coursework requirements.
- Student can apply for more than one opportunity.
- Each posting has specifics about duties, location, time frame, and skills.
- Please check back throughout the year as more opportunities may be posted.
 - *A resume is strongly encouraged for applications. If you do not have a resume and would like support creating one, please contact Connie Cook (ccook8@cherrycreekschools.org).*

Instructions for accessing the job board

Students must access the live job board and apply for positions using their student Cherry Creek credentials/log in. Parents and CCSD staff cannot see the live job board. Counselors will have a general list of what is available.

Step 1: Student, scan the QR code or visit https://cherrycreekschools.my.site.com/student/s/wbl-job-board.




Log in using your my.cherrycreek student login.



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Step 2: You will be brought to this page. If you did not land here, try clicking the Work-Based Learning Job Board tab at the top of the page.



Step 3: Scroll through the list to see what is available and click on blue job titles to see more detailed information.

Step 4: If you are interested in applying, the application is below the description of the position. You may apply for as many positions as you are interested in. Make sure you hit submit at the bottom when you are finished. You will not be able to go back and make edits after submitting.

Step 5: Every job will have a different close date. Pay attention to this date. You will not hear back from CCSD or the company until after this date. Make sure your voicemail is set up and not full and make sure you are checking the email that you provided. Some companies will call you, some will email you.



Frequently Asked Questions

1. There are no jobs on my job board. Why can't I see any?

Some internships or apprenticeships require prior or current CTE Courses to be eligible to apply. Students must have successfully completed or be currently enrolled in these CTE courses to be able to view specific positions. For a list of CTE Courses at your high school, visit this page:

4. I am not old enough to apply. How can I spend my time in school so that I am more prepared when I am eligible?

Take CTE electives and required PE/Health courses. Being on top of graduation requirements and taking CTE courses is the best way to prepare during your freshman, sophomore, and junior year.

5. I don't know if I can commit to the 2-to-3-year apprenticeship. I don't know if I am going to a college out of state or in-state (or if I'm going to college at all).

That's okay. We know that plans can change. If you are applying for an apprenticeship, you should currently have the intention of staying in state 1 to 2 years after high school graduation. If that ends up changing, that's okay.

6. I received an offer for an internship or apprenticeship? What do I do now?

The CCSD Work-Based Learning team will connect with you as soon as we are notified. If you don't hear from us, reach out. Sometimes students find out about offers days before we find out. We will find time to meet with you to discuss next steps (including school schedule, company onboarding, and expectations).

7. I have other commitments (another job, sports, CCIC courses). Can I still participate? We will do our best to create a school and work schedule that accommodates other commitments.
