

## From Principal Francis

Dear Cottonwood Families.

In an effort to keep families informed, we wanted to dedicate some space in this newsletter to better explain exactly how your fundraising money is used and how the PTO Sponsored position impacts our day to day life at Cottonwood. Today, we will explain how our Behavior Tech positions benefit our school. This is a unique position to Cottonwood that is only possible because of your fundraising support through our COT PTO. Most schools do



not have this position and we are grateful for your contributions. Thank you to all of you who support your neighborhood school through your time, your partnership, your kind words, and your giving!

The two Behavior Techs are members of the COT Mental Health team. They staff and run The Cougar Den, which is a classroom space that provides a sensory and self-regulation outlet for students. The Den is designed to provide students with a safe and controlled environment where they can actively manage their sensory input, allowing them to calm down, focus better, and regulate their emotions when feeling overwhelmed, thus improving their ability to learn and participate in classroom activities effectively. Teachers refer students to the Den if they feel the students need additional time and space beyond the supports already available in the classroom

setting, such as calm corners, whole class movement breaks and flexible seating, etc.. Students who participate in the Den program will have scheduled breaks to visit the Den and utilize the tools in the space to help with self-regulation which then benefits all classrooms and all students. In addition to individual break times, students in the Den program participate in weekly lessons on self-regulation with the Behavior Techs, through a curriculum called The Zones of Regulation. With the support of the Cougar Den and Behavior Techs, we see fewer disruptions to whole classroom learning. The Behavior Techs also participate in recess and lunch duty responsibilities to strengthen and build relationships with all students at Cottonwood during more unstructured times of the day.

Stay tuned for more information about other PTO sponsored positions as well as common language around self-regulation that can be used at home.

## School Of Choice

School of Choice (SOC) applications for the 24-25 school year are now being accepted. Through SOC, the Cherry Creek School District gives district residents and non-residents the opportunity to apply for enrollment in a Cherry Creek school of their choice. The first lottery will run in February 2024 on or before the 15th of the month. Subsequent lotteries will run bi-weekly starting February 28th.

Applications are considered based on lottery number and space availability for each school. Priority is given to students with siblings who will be attending the same school and children of district employees. There is a limit of one application per student, on which 3 different schools can be requested. Addresses must be up to date for residents of the school district in order to be considered for School of Choice. If you are moving at a later date, applications for School of Choice can be submitted once you move and update your address with the district admissions office.

Please note, School of Choice does NOT apply to you if:

- You live within the Cottonwood Creek boundaries and you want your child to attend our school.
- If your student was previously accepted through the SOC process to Cottonwood Creek, and continues to meet the eligibility criteria.
