## Important Health Reminder from the School Nurse

If your child sustains an injury, such as a bone fracture (wearing a cast, splint or brace) or other condition that may require accommodations at school, please notify the school nurse as soon as possible. In order to ensure your child receives the appropriate support, we ask that you provide a doctor's note detailing the nature of the injury, any physical limitations, and

recommended accommodations. This will help us coordinate with teachers and staff to ensure your child's safety and comfort while they recover.

## \* Cold Weather Recess

Dropping temperatures mean students will require outdoor clothing for recess.
