SCHOOL INFORMATION:

Attendance Reminders:

<u>Absences/Late Arrivals</u> - K-5 parents must leave a message on the attendance line (720) 554-3295 by 7:50 AM if your student will be absent or late. Please note that you need to include the reason for the absence or late arrival. If a reason is not provided, it will be considered unexcused. Please refer to pages 9 -11 of the <u>Student Conduct and Discipline</u>, <u>Rights and Responsibilities Responsibilities</u> for the District's policy on student absences and excuses.

<u>Tardy Arrivals</u> - The district does track the number of times a student arrives late. Although we understand that sometimes life circumstances are unavoidable, we ask that parents do their best to have students arrive on-time. The school day entails a tight schedule for both teachers and students so we need your help to reduce classroom interruptions. If possible, please try to keep your student's unexcused late arrivals under 10 occurrences over the course of the school year. Please reach out to the front office if there is a special circumstance we need to be aware of or can assist with.

<u>Late Pick-Ups:</u> Like tardy arrivals, we will also track late pick-ups. After dismissal, teachers and staff continue a busy schedule. Again, we are asking for your help by assuring that your student(s) are picked up on time. If you have conflicts that regularly prevent you from picking up on time, you might want to look into after school care. Cottonwood Creek has a <u>Before & After School Program</u> and there are a number of private child care centers in the area that offer after school programs.

Items dropped off for Students:

When dropping off items for students during the day (including lunches), please make sure they are labeled with their name and their teacher's name and delivered to the school by 9.30am. Items should be placed in the white cubby in the front vestibule for delivery. Remember, we do have water cups in the front office and lunch is free again this year.

Building Visitors:

Just a reminder that all building visitors must come through the main entrance and obtain a security badge from the front office. <u>Do not enter the building through the playground doors.</u> For safety, we do not want students or staff to get used to visitors walking around the building without a badge.
