Thunder Ridge Middle School Volleyball 2025



Dear Players and Parents-

- 8th and 7th grade girls' volleyball season begins Monday, March 24th
- 6th grade girls' volleyball season begins Wednesday, April 16th
- We feel the following policies are necessary to run an efficient and effective program.

ATTENDANCE

- Players must attend FIVE practices before they will be eligible to play in a game.
- After a missed practice, the player must have communication from a parent/teacher.
- If a student is absent from school, parent should notify the coach that the player will miss the practice or game that day.
- Players with one unexcused practice may receive reduced playing time the next game.
- Players who are not playing in an away game will not travel on the bus with the team.
- If a player plans to miss practice on a regular basis, because of a prior commitment, please inform the coaching staff. This also can have an effect on playing time.
- Players must be dressed and ready to practice by 3:55 PM. Players need to be in shorts, t-shirt, and appropriate court shoes (tied athletically) to be able to practice.

PRACTICE TIMES

- Practice will be held from 3:50-4:40 PM, Monday through Thursday **no practice Fridays**.
- Late busses are available for those who ride a bus to school. The late bus leaves school at 4:50 PM.

GAMES

- For home games, the players will be allowed to leave when their game/games are over, most of the time this is after the late busses have left, so they will need transportation.
- Busses will be provided for away games. One bus will return to TRMS and players will need transportation immediately upon return or they can walk home.
- Games will start approximately between 4:30-5:00 p.m. It depends on bus transportation.
- On game days, athletes are required to be in the gym by 3:50. Home game teams will meet in the big gym and away game teams will meet in the small gym.
- Players are allowed to ride home from away games with a parent after checking out with a coach, but they need a note to ride home with another player's parent (or indicate on the google form).

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

Any theft, fighting, vandalism, bullying or behavior, which discredits a player, teammates, or the school, is cause for dismissal from the team. Athletes, who are uncooperative with the coaching staff in practice, may be sent home. If this behavior continues, coaches/athletic director will communicate with parents and player may be subject to removal from the team.

ATHLETIC EMERGENCY CARD

As in any sport, an injury may occur in volleyball. However, we will take the necessary precautions to try to avoid any injury. No player will be allowed to practice or play unless the athletic emergency card is completed. (If this was completed from a previous sport this 24-25 school year, your child is good to go!)

FEES

A \$30.00 fee for 6th and 7th grade girls and a \$60.00 fee for 8th grade girls is required. Fees must be paid to the coach prior to the first game. Make checks out to TRMS. There will be no refunds of this money, unless there are extraordinary circumstances and the parents have contacted the athletic director. **Credit Card payment will be accepted online ONLY. Follow these directions!** Visit the Thunder Ridge website. Click on payments. Click on Middle Schools. Click on Thunder Ridge MS. Click on Athletics. Click on volleyball fee. Pay and please save a confirmation email/receipt just in case.

ORGANIZATION

There is a no-cut policy in middle school sports; every player who comes out will make a team. In **eighth** grade, there will be four teams, A, B, and two C teams. In **sixth** grade and **seventh** grade, players are split into three experienced (Red, Blue, Green) and three less experienced (Yellow, Orange, Purple) teams. Determining player positions and teams will be the coaches' decision based on the following factors:

- Demonstrated hustle, passing skills, serving, defensive skills, knowledge of assigned plays and their execution, team play, "coachability", and attitude.
- The best distribution of players to maintain team balance.
- Those things determined by the coaching staff to be best to help a player develop to her full potential.

UNIFORMS

JEWELRY IS NOT TO BE WORN DURING PRACTICE OR GAMES. The school will provide a game jersey to be worn only on game days. Each player is financially responsible for the uniform issued to them. If lost or damaged, the player will be charged a fee for replacement. <u>Please wash the uniforms in cold water...</u>air or line-dry the jerseys, **NO DRYER.**
